

Double Cribbage

2 Players

Summary:

While playing Cribbage in the Light Universe your cards are linked to a simultaneous game in the Dark Universe. Can you find a strategy to maximize your scores in both games?

You will need to already know the rules for standard Cribbage before trying this more complex version.

The Object:

Try to win two games of Cribbage at the same time! Each card you play will affect both your Light Hand score and your Dark Hand score so choose carefully.

The Deck:

Remove the Jokers from the deck.

The Board:

You will want to use a cribbage board to keep score. In this game each player will use one Light colored peg to represent their scores from the Light hand, and one Dark colored peg to represent their scores from their Dark hand. To remember who is who, one player will use the inside track, the other will use the outside track.

The Deal:

Deal 6 cards to each player.

The Play:

As in standard Cribbage, after the cards are dealt each player puts two cards from their hand into the Crib.

Play and score just as you would standard Cribbage, but keep the counts and scores separate for the Light and Dark sides.

Advance the Light pegs for points earned with the Light Hand and Dark pegs for the Dark Hand.

The End:

The game ends when a player gets BOTH their Light and Dark pegs across the finish line. Bonus accolades if you get both pegs across before your opponent gets either of theirs across.
